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Role of *Ayurvedic* formulation in the management of *Kitibha Kushtha* w. r. s. to Plaque Psoriasis -A case Study

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Abstract:-

In 21st century skin diseases are common due to altered life style, mental stress and improper food habits. All the skin diseases in ayurveda have been discussed under the broad heading of ' Kushta'. Kushta is divided into Maha kushta and kitibh Kushta' kshudra *Kushta*[10] (plaque psoriasis) is included under kshudra Kushta which having signs and symptoms similar to Plaque Psoriasis . It needs long time treatment due to its relapsing nature. Ayurvedic Treatment plays an important role in management of plaque psoriasis by decreasing it's symptoms and inhibit reoccurence of disease. A 52 yrs old male patient came to kaychikitsa OPD with complaining of shyava Varna (blackish spot all over body), ruksha pidika (dry vesicles), with with kandu treated Gandhak rasayan,mahatiktak ghrit, mahaman ji sthadi kwath and dermocare oil for LA . Patient got

significant relief in symptoms.Better results achieved in this case using shaman chikitsa along with Bahirparimarjan chikitsa (External application).

Introduction:-

- Now we are in 21st century due to urbanization and industrialization, there is drastic changes in life style of human being. These all factors play an important role in
- Raktadushti and dosha vrudhi which leads to skin diseases especially kushta. In ayurveda all skin diseases have been discussed under the broad heading of Kushta'.
- Among all skin diseases
 'Psoriasis' is very distressing for both patients and physicians

because of its pathogenic mechanism. Psoriasis is chronic inflammatory *hyperproliferative* skin disease. It is characterised by well-defined erythematous scaly Plaque and usually follows a relapsing and remitting course[1]. All signs of Plaque Psoriasis similar with *Kitibh Kushta*.

- Kitibh Kushta is vata and kapha doshpradhan disease with lakshanas of both dosha. Kitibh Kushta manifests due to deranged physiology of seven factors. They kapha, are vata. pitta, tvak(skin),mamsa(muscle),shonit(blood) lasika(lymphatic and system).
- Kushta is mentioned in ashtamahagad [8]i.e difficult to treat by Acharya Charak. Kitibh Kushta is having symptoms like shyava Varna (discolouration), kina,khara sparsha (rough in touch / scaly), parushatva (hard), ruksha pidika (dry vesicles) with kandu (itching)[6].

Case Report:-

A 52 yrs. old male patient came in *kaychikitsa* OPD on date 08/07/22 of L.K. *Ayurvedic* Hospital Yavatmal with chief complaints of *shyava Varna* (blackish spot all over the body), *Ruksha pidika* (dry vesicles) with *kandu* (itching) since 12-13 yrs. and for further management he was admitted in ward.

Past History of Illness:-

He is having type-2 diabetes mellitus with Hypertension since 6 months and on medications Tab.Metformin 500,Tab. Telmisartan40mg and Tab.Amlodipine 5mg

History of present illness:-

Patient was normal before 12-13 yrs then having complaints of itching over left leg followed by small blackish spot all over the body which increases gradually and spread as dry blackish spot all over body he had no family history of any skin diseases. He consulted all allopathic physicians before but he didn't get relief, so he came to our hospital for further management and treatment.

➤ Mode of action of Mahamanjisthadi kwath:-

It contain *Manjistha*, *Haldi*, *Daru haldi*, *Harad*, *Behada*,

Amla, Patel, Guduchi, Nimba, Khadir, chandan etc[2]. Similarly It contain all raktashudhikar dravya. It help in purification process of the blood that helps to reduce toxins from blood. It can help to maintain Skin complexion.

- Mode of action of Gandhaka

 Rasayana:Gandhaka rasayana
 membrane with mercury purified sulphur
 used in many disease. Internal & external
 both route of purified sulphur used to
 treat skin disease.
- ➤ Mode of action of *Mahatiktaak Ghrita* [3]:-

Mahatiktaak Ghrita is explained in bhaishajyaratnavali, In Kushtadhyay. Ingredients of it having Kushtaghna [9]Property. Goghrita is vaat-Pitta shamak, Twachya useful in healing and has a 'Samskarasya Anuwartanam[11]Property(without losing own properly, assimilates the properties of other Substance with which it is processed). So Mahatiktaak Ghrita becomes more effective in psoriasis.

➤ Mode of action of Dermocare oil:-

Dermocare oil is useful in Skin diseases like Psoriasis, itching, eczema due to its Kushtaghna Property. Ingredients of Dermocare oil Pacify Tridosha, moisturizes the skin & improve skin complexion

Conclusion:-

In Kushtha Chikitsa both Shodhana[7] and Shamana therapy plays very important role. Rugna bala is hean so we have only given Shaman Chikitsa[4]. Symptoms of Plaque

Psoriasis is similar to *Kitibha Kushtha*. This Case Study concluded that *Kitibha Kushta* can be cured with Shaman chikitsa. By combination of *Ayurvedic* Modalities like *Shaman chikitsa* (along with *Bahir parimarjan Chikitsa*). better results can be achieved.

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
